Happy New Year

New Year, new gear? New rules to watch for. The legality of equipment being used at a tournament is always the responsibility of the archer. Make sure you check the most current rulebook ([Archery Canada](#), [World Archery](#), [NFAA](#), [IFAA](#), [IBO](#), etc) to ensure that your gear complies with the rules for the tournament. In addition to your gear, ensure that your *body* is also in compliance. The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) issued the [2018 Prohibited List](#) which is effective January 1st. Over and above the WADA regulations, World Archery has passed a [bylaw to continue the ban of alcohol in competition](#).

Have you renewed your membership yet?

Memberships expire December 31st. Don't miss out on shooting a registered tournament or other benefits, renew now! Some clubs require you to be a valid BCAA member in order to participate. Starting next month only 2018 members will have the newsletter emailed to them.

The fastest way to renew/join is to [complete the online form and pay with a credit card](#). Your new card can then be emailed to you. (Please allow up to 2 weeks for processing, could be longer through the December/January busy renewal season).

Clubs: If you need an Insurance Certificate or run a JOP program, you may face delays if the club membership has not been renewed. To avoid further processing delays, anyone listed as the Club's Coaches, Safety Officers/Judges should renew at the same time as the Club renews. Not sure if your club has renewed? Starting February 1, only clubs in-good-standing will be listed on the [Club Directory](#) of the BC Archery website.

High Performance Funding application deadline—January 31st
