Memberships expire December 31st—renew now!

Memberships expire December 31st. Don't miss out on shooting a registered tournament or other benefits, renew now! Some clubs require you to be a valid BC Archery member in order to participate. Renew now and don't get turned away at your next club night.

The fastest way to renew/join is to [complete the online form and pay with a credit card](#). Your new card will be emailed to you. (Please allow up to 2 weeks for processing, could be longer through the December/January busy renewal season).

Clubs: club renewals are due by January 1st. If you need an Insurance Certificate or run a JOP program, you may face delays if the club membership has not been renewed. To avoid further processing delays, anyone listed as the Club's Coaches, Safety Officers/ Judges should renew at the same time as the Club renews. The Club renewal will be held until those persons are listed as "in-good-standing" for 2019.

High Performance Funding application deadline—January 31st
