Memberships expire December 31st—renew now!

Memberships expire December 31st. Don't miss out on shooting a registered tournament or other benefits, renew now! Some clubs require you to be a valid BC Archery member in order to participate. Renew now and don't get turned away at your next club night.

The fastest way to renew/join is to [complete the online form and pay with a credit card](#). Your new card will be emailed to you. (Please allow up to 2 weeks for processing, could be longer through the December/January busy renewal season).

Club Affiliation: if a club needs to renew, these should be complete by January 1st in case you need an Insurance Certificate or run a JOP program. To avoid processing delays, anyone listed as the Club's Coaches, Safety Officers/Judges should renew at the same time as the Club renews. The Club renewal will be held until those persons are listed as "in-good-standing" for 2020. New requirements for Club Affiliation are in effect. If you truly love 3D and want to see how you measure up against people across Canada, check out the [3D Indoor Mailmatch](#). Clubs could hold the mailmatch concurrently with an already scheduled 3D event. The event would need to be registered with Archery Canada and officiated by a certified provincial 3D judge. Only 10 targets are required for the mailmatch event. The [AC website](#) has details and contact information.

Rule changes

World Archery now includes Barebow in most of their competitive events. Effective January 1, 2020, Barebow will be recognized for World Records. As Archery Canada has recognized this equipment category in the past, the only change is the distance and target faces shot for outdoor target tournaments. [Click here for the Barebow updates](#).
