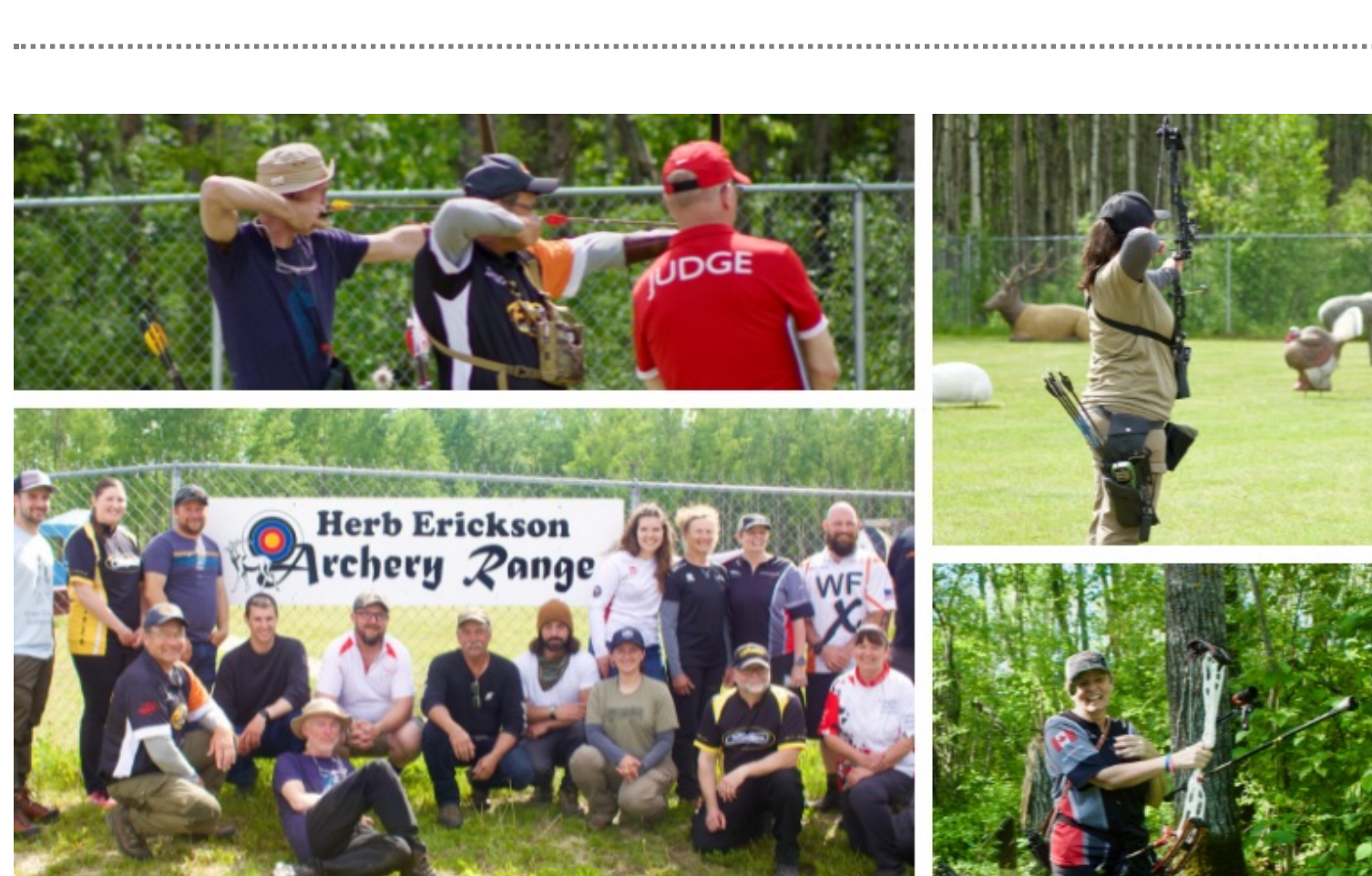
## Correction

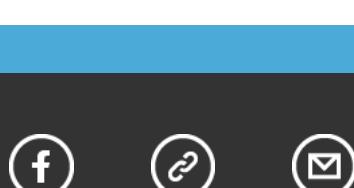
