The Abbotsford 2023 55+ BC Games takes place from August 22nd to 26th, 2023. Archery will be a three-day competition which will allow participants to choose from compound bows with a sight and release aid, recurve bows with or without a sight, and longbows. The competition includes shooting at distances of 55 yards, 45 yards, and 35 yards in the 900 round. In the 3D event, the shooting distance varies based on the archer's equipment: compound bows at 35 meters and other bows at 30 meters. More information can be found here.
