Archery Tips to 'Extinguish' Wildfire Worries

With the 2023 wildfire season in British Columbia set to become one of the worst on record, make sure to consider these safety tips while participating in archery.

- **1. Stay Informed:** Be aware of <u>wildfire warnings</u>, air quality alerts and safety recommendations issued by local authorities. Stay updated through official channels and news sources to make informed decisions about when and where to shoot.
- 2. Relocate if Needed: If your regular archery range is close to wildfires or in an area with heavy smoke, consider relocating to a safer location. Be flexible and prioritize your safety over convenience.
- **3. Carry Emergency Supplies**: Always carry essential emergency supplies, such as a first aid kit, a fully charged phone and plenty of water.
- **4. Develop an Evacuation Plan:** Familiarize yourself with the evacuation routes and shelter locations in your area. Have a well-thought-out evacuation plan and ensure everyone in your group is aware of it.
- **5. Know Fire Bans:** Be aware of any fire bans or restrictions in your area. Avoid the use of open flames, including campfires and barbecues, during periods of high fire danger.

Remember, your safety and well-being are important. Enjoy archery responsibly! Stay safe, stay informed,




Coaching Clinics - Save the Dates!

Make sure there's space on your calendar for two upcoming coaching clinics:

Instructor of Intermediate Archers Clinic, Coquitlam, BC | **September 9-10, 2023.** This clinic teaches coaches how to refine basic skills, and introduces a variety of more complex techniques to individuals who already have some experience in archery and who already exhibit a fair degree of proficiency in shooting. <u>Register here.</u>

Instructor of Beginners Archers Clinic, Coquitlam, BC | **October 21-22, 2023** This course will provide an introduction to the principles and techniques of instructing and training archers. Topics covered will include various scenarios and teaching methods. Register here.

Please note that the NCCP required "Making Ethical Decisions" training is not included in these clinics. It is the coach's responsibility to complete that training and evaluation separately in order to be certified by the Coaching Association of Canada.

Moreover, the PA handles communications with coaches and athletes, participant registrations, arranges

Trials events with regional clubs, and assists the VP-Athlete Development with Zone Team Selections, coach selections, and more!

To get a better idea of the requirements, please read the Games' Role of the Provincial Advisor document from the 2022 Vernon Games.

If this role piques your interest, you will initially serve as the Assistant Provincial Advisor for the 2024 Quesnel Games. Then, in 2026, you will transition to become the Provincial Advisor, while the current PA will act as your Assistant PA, providing further training and support.



Archery Coaches Needed for BC Winter Games

The upcoming **BC Winter Games** in Quesnel from **February 21-25, 2024**, are in need of volunteer coaches for each Games zone.

Head coaches must have a minimum certification as an Instructor of Intermediate Archers, and assistant coaches must have a minimum certification as an Instructor of Beginner Archers. Each zone requires one head coach and one assistant coach.

By volunteering as a coach, you will enable youth from your zone to participate in the event. Without coaches, eligible youth from that zone won't be able to join the Games.
