

From May to September you can find them at Selvey Park in east Maple Ridge, where they also hosted the Canada Cup multiple times in the past. The main focus of the club is target shooting, though they also have a stash of 3D animals and Field targets to create a flat 3D / Field course for those interested. Maple Ridge has an active JOP program and usually hosts the Indoor JOP Championships for the Lower Mainland Clubs (though members from other clubs throughout BC are also welcome).
