BC Archery believes in providing a safe environment for all archery participants at all levels. Starting with the 2021 application year, Clubs wishing to be affiliated with BC Archery / Archery Canada will need to agree to abide by all BC Archery policies (as may be found on our website) and/or to provide adequate/similar policies of their own for their participants/members, along with providing proof of good standing with the Province (supply copy of annual report of Society or Corporation). Effective the 2020 affiliation year, Clubs should make themselves familiar with and begin to implement these policies at their facilities. Also effective the 2020 affiliation year, Clubs must ensure that anyone working with or having unsupervised access to youth and/or vulnerable adults must have a current, clear CRC check on file with BC Archery, AND any judges/Safety Officers must sign an acknowledgment of their responsibilities.
