

Purpose: To encourage and promote participation in all 3 Provincial Championship events.

Process / Criteria:

- 1. Must be a member-in-good-standing of BC Archery.
- 2. Must declare intention to participate before the BC Indoor Championships (earliest event in the year)
- 3. Pay the entry fee at time of declaration
- 4. Scores of each athlete, from each of the events, will be cumulated to determine placing.
- 5. Awards issued to top three (3) athletes in each "crown" category

Events included in the Triple Crown:

- 1. BC Indoor Championships (Target)
- 2. BC 3D Championships (Outdoor)
- 3. BC Outdoor Championships (Target, and possibly Field)

"Crown" Categories

The Triple Crown offers the following 3D type categories:

- 1. Youth Co-ed Compound (includes PeeWee, PreCub and Cub)
- Youth Co-ed Traditional (includes PeeWee, PreCub and Cub)
- 3. Known50 Co-ed (orange stake shooters)
- 4. White Stake Men (all traditional/recurve shooters)
- 5. White Stake Women (all traditional/recurve shooters)
- 6. Green Stake Men
- 7. Green Stake Women
- 8. Orange Stake Men (excluding K50)
- 9. Orange Stake Women (excluding K50)

Awards

The top athlete in each "crown" category will receive recognition as winner of the Triple Crown. A total of 9 awards will be issued (provided there are no ties). If a Crown Category has a tie, the tie will be broken by number of 10s/11s/Xs/6s (Indoor Target/3D/Outdoor Target/Field). If there is still a tie, then 2 awards will be presented for that category.
